1 EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

Exploration Permit 15814, Westwood, was granted as 100 sub-blocks located at Westwood in central Queensland. The tenement was acquired with the aim of exploring for gold mineralisation and investigating uranium anomalies in the regional radiometric data.

Forty five sub-blocks are being relinquished at the end of the first year of tenure.

The Westwood area lies in the Bucknella Province of central Queensland. The project area is dominated by the Lower Permian Rookwood Volcanics.

Work on the tenement included a literature review, data compilation, geological reconnaissance and geochemical sampling. A geological consultant with uranium exploration expertise was also brought in to review the project. Five rock chip samples were collected from the relinquished sub-blocks in association with geological reconnaissance.

2 TENEMENT STATUS

EPM 15814, Westwood, was granted as a 100 sub-block EPM to ActivEX Limited on 12 December 2006 for a period of 5 years. The grant was approximately 312 square kilometres and the permit is due to expire on 11 December 2011.

This report details the forty five sub-blocks being relinquished at the end of the first year of tenure.

There are no Mining Leases or ML applications within the permit area.

3 LOCATION AND ACCESS

Figure 1

The project area is centred on the small town of Westwood, approximately 50km southwest of Rockhampton in central Queensland. The tenement lies in the western portion of the Rockhampton 1:250,000 sheet area and is centred on longitude 150°7' E and latitude 23°38' S.

The area is pastoral land and forest, utilised predominantly for cattle grazing and is accessed by secondary bitumen roads and station tracks.

4 NATIVE TITLE

There is one Native Title Claim Application present in the project area. The Application by the Darumbal People (National Native Title Tribunal Application QC97/21) covers the entire permit area.

5 EXPLORATION RATIONALE

Exploration Permit for Minerals 15814, Westwood, was acquired to investigate uranium anomalies evident in regional radiometric data and to explore for gold mineralisation.

6 GEOLOGY AND MINERALISATION

The relinquished area is dominated by the Rookwood Volcanics. The Early Permian Rookwood Volcanics consist predominantly of spilitic lavas, basaltic lavas, and minor vitric tuffs and were deposited as part of the Grantleigh Trough sequence. In the south-east corner of the tenement, the Early Permian Youlambie Conglomerate is conformably overlain by the Rookwood Volcanics.

The Kyle Mohr Granodiorite complex occurs in the east of the tenement, in the relinquished area, and is inferred to be of Late Permian age by Kirkegaard and others (1970). Rock types consist dominantly of granodiorite, with lesser granite and tonalite.

The old Westwood gold mine lies in the relinquished area. It consists of a shaft and a series of small pits working east-west and north-south trending quartz-arsenopyrite-gold lodes, associated with gabbro-dolerite dykes. Approximately 250 tonnes yielded 150oz of gold (19g/t Au) (Rankine, 1983).

7 EXPLORATION

7.1 PROJECT REVIEW

A geological consultant with uranium exploration expertise was brought in to review the project. After identifying several areas of interest, geological reconnaissance was undertaken.

A hand-held scintillometer was utilised in assessing anomalous areas identified from the regional radiometric data (uranium channel). The anomalous areas were found to be small in extent and low in total count. No anomalies worthy of follow-up were identified during fieldwork.

7.2 DATA REVIEW

Several historic workings are known in the project area, including the Westwood gold mine. Previous mineral exploration of the area within and surrounding the project area has been undertaken by several companies since the late 1960's.

BHP held the ground from 1968-1972 under **ATP 532M** and completed substantial grid based exploration for copper and nickel. Work included an airborne magnetic & radiometric survey, mapping, ground magnetics, IP surveys, stream sediment and soil sampling, and drilling.

Central Pacific Minerals NL (CPM) in joint venture with Southern Pacific Petroleum NL and Messrs Mackenzie, Forbes and Clark, held the ground under **ATPs 4189 & 4190M**. CPM regridded the Westwood Layered Gabbro Prospect and carried out detailed ground magnetics & radiometrics and soil geochemistry assaying for Cu, Au, Pt, and Pd. A regional stream sediment sampling survey covering 1428 sites was also completed. 10 holes were drilled.

CRA held the ground under **ATP 3700M**, and completed ground magnetics and radiometrics, soil and rock sampling over the Westwood Gold Mine.

Queensland Metals Corp (QMC) held the area as part of the **Fitzroy Project** during the 1990's. The Westwood Project is covered by **EPMs 9418, 9419, 9589 & 9669**. QMC carried out extensive work, but most was focussed on the Develin Creek prospect. Only the Kiowa Prospect occurs within the relinquished area. This prospect was identified during mid-1994 by drainage sampling as a strong, dominantly zinc + copper + gold + cobalt anomaly. Detailed grid based work included rock chip sampling, geological mapping, RAB and RC drilling, and IP surveying. Percussion drilling of a shallow chargeability anomaly failed to intersect significant mineralisation although weakly elevated Cu-Zn values were returned.

Rio Tinto held the ground under **EPM 11891** during the late 1990's. Work included mapping and aeromagnetic interpretation, an EM survey and rock chip sampling.

Glengarry carried out work on the Westwood layered gabbro under **EPMs 13664 & 13305**. Work included stream sediment, soil & rock chip sampling, an airborne EM survey, and RC drilling. Most work was to the north of the relinquished area.

7.3 SURFACE SAMPLING

5 rock chip samples were collected from the 45 relinquished sub-blocks. Samples were collected in conjunction with geological traversing.

All samples were sent to ALS Chemex in Brisbane for analysis. Samples were assayed for Au, Ag, Al, As, Ba, Be, Bi, Ca, Cd, Ce, Co, Cr, Cu, Fe, K, La, Mg, Mn, Mo, Na, Ni, P, Pb, S, Sb, Se, Sr, Te, Th, Ti, U, V, W, and Zn.

Results were below detection limit for Au, Ag, and several other elements. A maximum of 1.5ppm U was returned, from WWR006.

8 CONCLUSIONS

The sub-blocks relinquished have been the subject of limited field inspection. Results from rock chips were not anomalous and the area offers little potential for economic mineralisation.

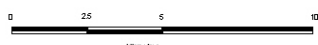


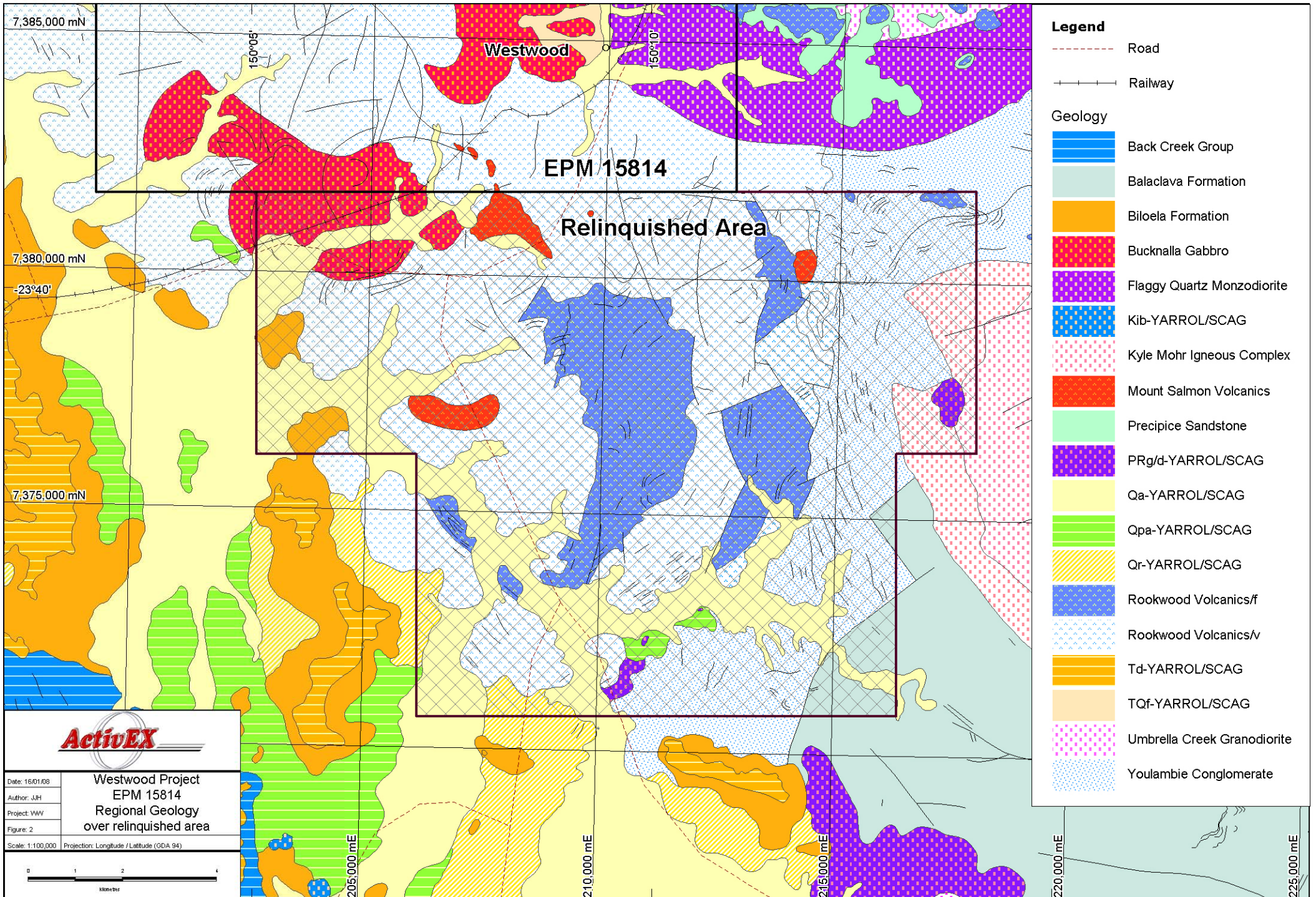

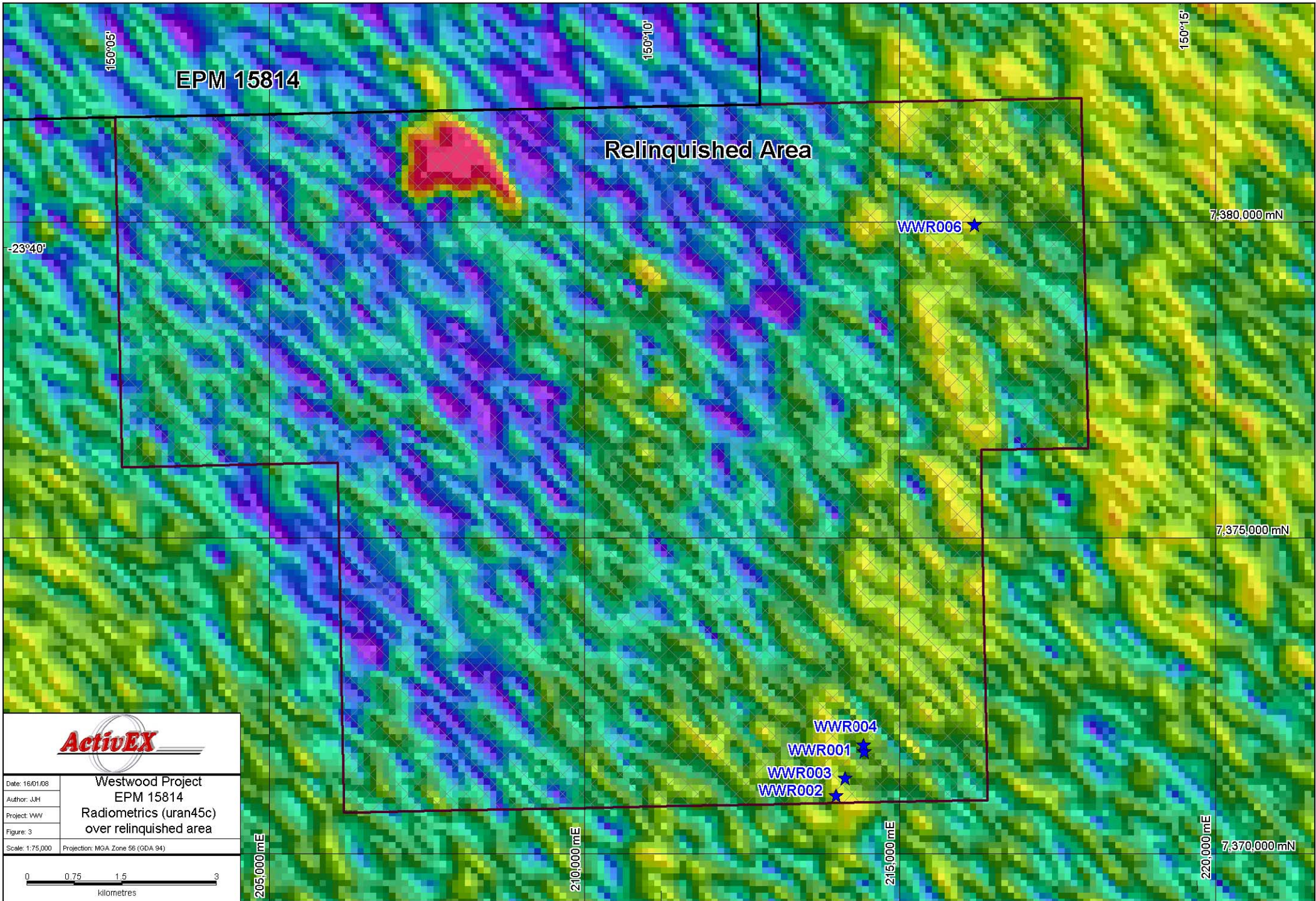
